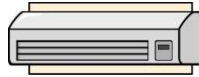

2017 Residential Fall Mini Split Rebate Program Requirements



Rebate Eligibility Requirements and Rebate Amounts

- Rebates will be offered on full heat pump systems only (outdoor unit and indoor unit(s) – manufacturer/distributors approved matches). **NOTE: PECO Smart Home Rebates can be combined with this EAP rebate. No other rebates may be combined with EAP rebates.**
- **NOTE:** MANUFACTURERS/DISTRIBUTORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO LIMIT REBATES WITH RESPECT TO CERTAIN PRODUCT LINES. ANY SUCH RESERVATIONS MUST BE COMMUNICATED TO PARTICIPATING CONTRACTORS AT THE **BEGINNING** OF THE PROGRAM. CONTRACTORS, IN TURN, SHOULD VERIFY EQUIPMENT COMPLIANCE WITH THE MANUFACTURER/DISTRIBUTORS **BEFORE** PROMISING A REBATE TO A CUSTOMER.
- Residential **Single Zone** High Efficiency Equipment (Manufacturer/Distributor Approved Matches): **\$100 per outdoor unit on a 20.0 SEER, 9.6 HSPF, 12.5 EER (or higher) heat pump system**
- Residential **Multi Zone** High Efficiency Equipment (Manufacturer/Distributor Approved Matches): **\$75 per head on a 16.0 SEER, 9.0 HSPF, 12.0 EER (or higher) heat pump system (NEW!)**

Manufacturer/Distributor/Contractor Eligibility Requirements

- All manufacturers/distributors and contractors must have paid their dues in full for 2017.
- Equipment for project quotes and / or new construction quotes is excluded from this offer. This offer is not valid in combination with other rebates.
- **NOTE:** Equipment purchased from Home Improvement or other Retail Stores is not eligible.

Rebate Payment Information

- Eligible consumers receive the rebate through a deduction for the full rebate amount on the customer's invoice.
- The manufacturer/distributors and contractor **equally share the cost of the rebate.** Following installation, the contractor must file a claim with The EAP to receive the manufacturer's half of the rebate amount.
- Manufacturer/Distributors **must reimburse contractors within 15 days of receiving claim forms.**
- Contracts may not be signed before **Wednesday, August 9, 2017.**
- Contracts must be signed by **Wednesday, November 15, 2017.**
- Systems must be installed by **Wednesday, December 6, 2017.**
- Contractors must file claims, including the completed claim form, an original invoice, and AHRI rating sheet, on or before **Wednesday, December 13, 2017.** PLEASE SCAN OR MAIL FORMS (NOT BOTH). **NO FAXES PLEASE.**

NOTE: Dates for the 2017 Fall Rebate Program **WILL NOT** be extended.
